

"Nurture Festival is back, and this year's event promises to be bigger and better than ever, with an array of activities and community partnerships designed to foster youth mental wellness.



### **Our Guest Speaker**

How good to have District Chair of Inner Wheel District A77, Leeanne Ballinger, as our guest speaker at last week's meeting.

Inner Wheel is the largest international women's volunteer organisation in the world, with over a hundred and four thousand members. It is a friendship club based on service to the community, nationally and internationally.

Leeanne spoke on Inner Wheel's long-term donations for stem cell research, which has amounted to over \$3.7 million since 2002. This has resulted in sixty-two research grants being given out for the continuation of vital Cord Blood and Stem Cell Research.

Leeanne has nominated <u>DV Safe Phone</u> as her charity for Inner Wheel to support this year and requested that Mooloolaba Rotary Club members donate any old phones they may have, which will be refurbished and provided to domestic violence survivors.

Also, Leeanne's home club, the Inner Wheel Club of Sunshine Coast, is holding a 'Two for Ten Walk' on Sunday September 29th, 2024, in support of Cord Blood Research, if Mooloolaba Rotary members would like to participate.
